EARN EVERY NOTE

We believe audiences deserve a live concert experience. That's why every vocal harmony, guitar solo, keyboard part, bass line and drum fill is performed live by the musicians on stage. There are no backing tracks and no prerecorded vocals—just five musicians listening to one another, responding in the moment and creating every musical moment together.

The excitement of live music is knowing every note is happening right in front of you.

THE SONG IS THE STAR

Every musician enjoys the opportunity to showcase their talent, a tribute band has a different responsibility,

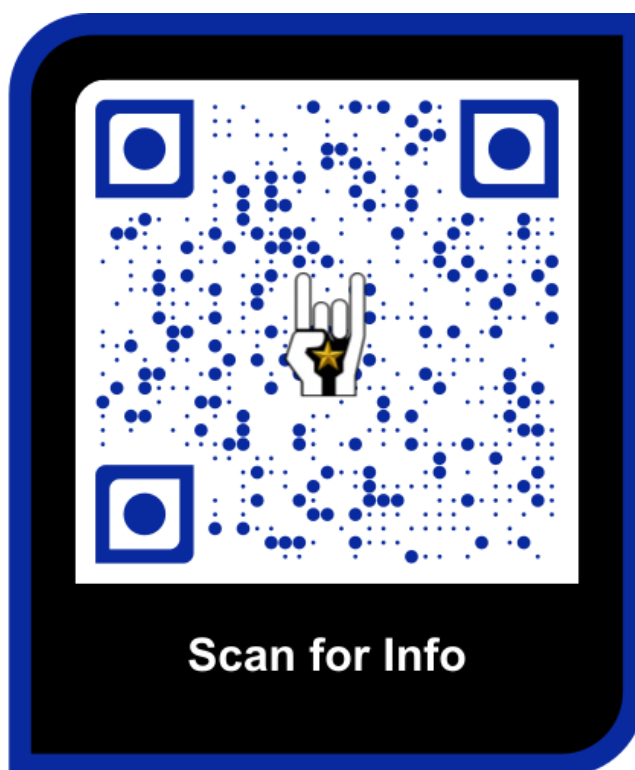

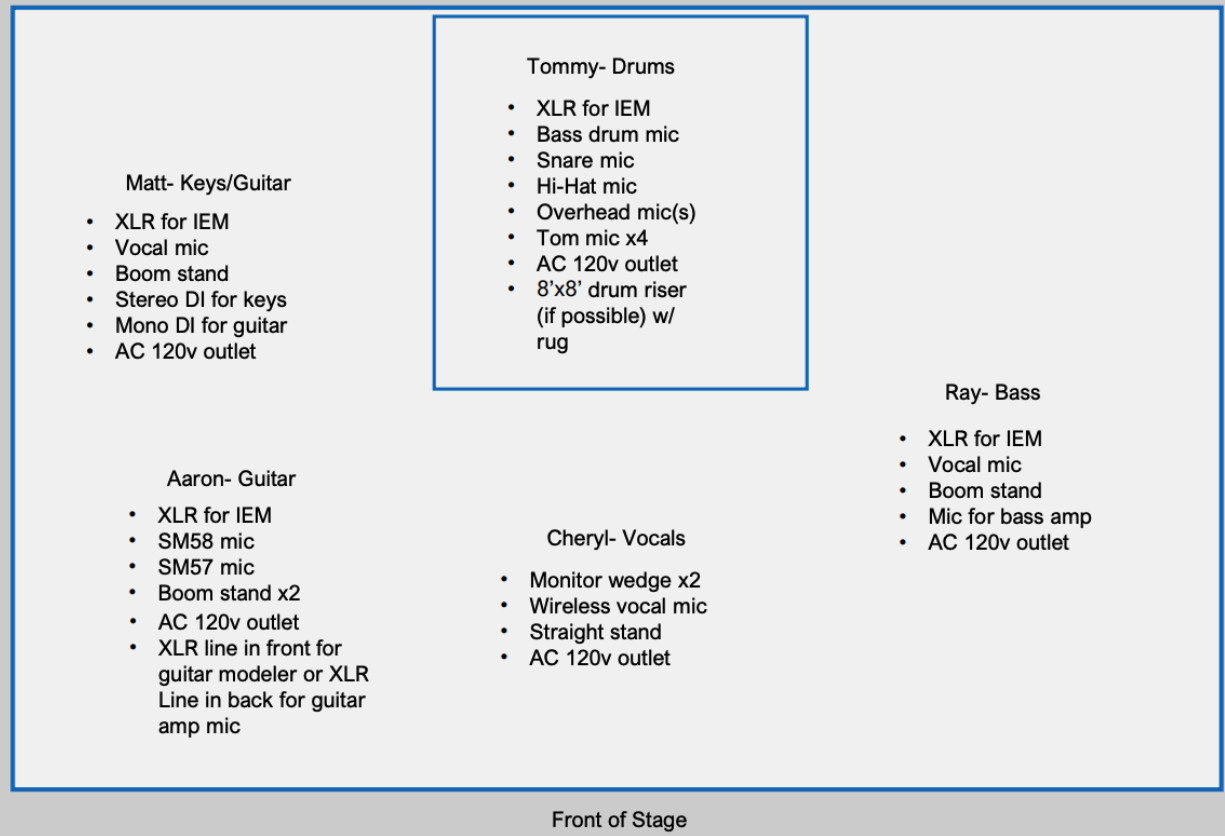

Cheryl, Vocals-

- Marshall DSL100HR head or similar (EVH 5150iii, etc)
- Marshall 4x12 cab or similar
- Guitar stand

Matt, Keys/Guitar-

Ray, Bass-

Tommy, Drums (right handed setup)-

- 8'x8' riser with a rug at least 5'x7'
- Drums- DW/Tama/Ludwig/Pearl/Yamaha or other professional level maple or birch
 - One bass drum- 20"x16"/18" or 22"x16"/18".
 - One snare drum- 14"x6"/6.5"/7"/7.5"/8" brass/aluminum/maple/birch.
 - Two rack (mounted) toms on separate stands.
 - Two floor toms (floor toms preferred for the larger two toms), can substitute two rack (mounted) toms of equal diameter.
 - Tom size configuration.
 - 10"/12"/14"/16" or 12"/14"/16"/18"
 - Heads preferred, not a requirement-
 - Bass- Clear Evans EMAD or Clear Remo PowerStroke 3.
 - Snare- Remo/Evans coated single or double ply top head. Please, no Evans HD Dry top snare head.
 - Toms- Remo/Evans clear two ply on top, single ply is also acceptable.
 - Prefer heads to be in excellent to new condition with no muffling.
- Hardware- DW/Tama/Ludwig/Pearl/Yamaha heavy duty (double braced) stands and pedals.
 - Seven heavy duty cymbal stands. Can be a mix of seven boom or six boom and one straight or five boom and two straight stands. One cymbal is a splash so it can be hung off the side of another stand if needed.
 - One heavy duty double bass pedal, preferred. A single pedal is fine. Either chain drive or strap drive is preferred. Direct drive pedals are not preferred unless that is all there is available.
 - One heavy duty hi-hat stand.
 - One heavy duty snare stand.

- Two heavy duty tom stands, three if floor toms are not used.
- One heavy duty drum throne, round or bicycle seat style.
- One small table or music stand that can be used as a table on the left near the HH stand.
